#### Insurance Woes Across the Nation Hitting Home to Our Churches

All three of our Charge Churches recently received notice of a rather drastic increase in property and liability insurance premiums. Each Church is facing a 40% increase in premium costs despite much higher deductibles. Representatives from each Church met with our long-term agent, Beth Kroeger. Beth explained the rationale for the increases and offered a few strategies for reducing the premiums.

The cause of the increases has to do with the increased number of catastrophic, weather related claims nationwide. Insurance companies are required to maintain reserves and purchase re-insurance from even larger insurance companies. Of course their increased costs are passed along to the end-consumers like us regardless of our claim history.

Another factor playing into the increase is the Wisconsin Conference requiring all Churches to maintain minimum coverage limits, often way beyond what small Churches need or can afford. Beth offered that Conference staff is meeting with Church Mutual representative to hopefully get some relief from those mandates. Sadly, even with those changes insurance will still be expensive.

Advisory Boards from each Church will be facing some challenging decisions. Rest assured, they will do their best to do what's best for Our Churches.



1. Meeting began with prayer led by Pastor Paul.

2. Introduction of Brenda Cigan as new Finance Chair with an explanation of her role and the role of others within the Finance Committee was done.

3. Jeff, Brenda and Pastor Paul will meet with Carla to tell Carla of the change in the Finance Committee and that Kathy Yeager has agreed to volunteer as the treasurer.

4. Brenda will call Carla to schedule the appointment. Her phone number is (715)271-4758. The meeting will be scheduled for Thursday, June 27<sup>th</sup> at 10:00, if possible.

5. Kathy will speak to the bank regarding changes and what information will be needed from committee members.

6. Kathy would like to use paper checks and not a computerized program.

7. Kathy will write checks for the month and Jeff and Brenda will review and sign the checks before each Ad board meeting.

8. 2 people will be required to sign checks and that will be Jeff Anders and Brenda Cigan with Deb Horecka as the backup.

9. Kathy discussed having access to the 501(c)(3) and other tax numbers and possibly having a bank credit card.

10. It was decided that Script cards would be purchased to have available for others, such as kitchen staff, to use instead of individuals having to pay out of their pocket and then get reimbursed at a later time.

11. Membership for the 3 churches is how the percentage of payment is determined. At the present time Holcombe pays 65%, Jim falls 25% and Anson 10%.

12. Discussion occurred on the need to reevaluate membership and if this is a fair distribution of funds.

13. Additional Finance Committee meetings will be scheduled as needed.

14. The Ad Board meets every 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday at 5:00.
